

CF Masters Canoe Marathon World Championships

Participation and Payment Terms

According to the program guide published on the [page](#), you can participate in the ICF Kayak-Canoe Marathon Masters World Championship (hereinafter: Marathon Masters World Championship) organized by the Hungarian Kayak-Canoe Association (1138 Budapest, Latorca utca. 2.; tax number: 18160037-2-41; registration number: 01-07-0000016; hereinafter: Organizer) by accepting and adhering to the participation and payment conditions (hereinafter: GTC) set out below.

1. You can register and enter the Marathon Masters World Championships online, from April 15, 2025 to August 21, 2025 (CET) at 23:59, on entry.gyor2025.com, by providing the necessary registration data, the competition numbers, and the requested services, and by paying the participation fee. Registration and entry for the competition is done individually. Each competitor is individually responsible for their own participation and for the administrative activities related to their entry. You can create a new registration or modify the parameters of an existing registration on the online interface during the specified period, taking into account the following exceptions. Registration, entry and reservations can be finalized by completing the payment transaction. After the payment transaction is completed, the system considers the specified parameters as final and closed, even if the payment transaction takes place before the registration deadline. After the payment transaction, the parameters specified on the interface cannot be modified! After the registration period, registrations that have not been finalized with a payment transaction will not be processed by the system and will be placed in an invalid status.

2. Method of payment, confirmation and invoicing of participation fees, lunch, parking requests, T-shirt requests, and accompanying person accreditation: based on the parameters provided on the registration interface, the system will total the participation fee to be paid. The participation fee can be paid via the online interface with a bank card or Barion wallet. Online bank card payments are made through the Barion system. The bank card details are not sent to the Organizer. The payment service provider Barion Payment Zrt. is an institution supervised by the Hungarian National Bank, its license number: H-EN-I-1064/2013. Payment by bank transfer or cash is not possible.

Due to the deposit, the amount will be blocked in the bank account. This means that after the full entry fee is charged, the money will not be immediately transferred to the Organizer. Instead, it will be locked (or disabled) until the end of the event. During the lock-in period, the Organizer has the right to decide whether to finalize or partially finalize the purchase, which will facilitate the processing of the deposit.

If the booking is successful, the registration will be recorded. Upon successful registration, an automatic confirmation email will be sent to the email address provided by the competitor.

Banks handle the release of the amount in different ways. Because of this, it may take a few days for the balance to reappear after the blocked amount is released. The system will send the invoice for the amount paid to the email address provided by the competitor after the Marathon Masters World Championships.

Entrants have the option to cancel the registration and requested services recorded by payment transaction until July 1, 2025; after July 1, 2025, no refund request can be submitted to the organizers.

3. During registration, competitors provide the following information:

- Competitor's personal details and ID photo,
- Address data, billing data,
- Personal details and ID photo of the accompanying person,
- Entry into the chosen competition(s),
- Lunch reservations for the competitor and accompanying person on a daily basis,
- Parking sticker purchase request for the competitor,
- T-shirt purchase request.

During registration, you accept the terms and conditions of participation and payment, as well as the data protection information containing the rules for handling the above data.

The Service Provider is not liable for any damages resulting from inaccuracies in the data provided during registration.

4. On-site registration and entry:

The Organizer will accept on-site registration and entries on August 30, 2025 between 9:00 AM and 4:00 PM, and on August 31, 2025 between 9:00 AM and 2:00 PM, for an additional administration fee in addition to the normal entry fee.

5. Participation fees:

The participation fee for competitors in individual, pair and mixed pair events depends on how many events the competitor has entered:

- Entry for 1 competition: 75 EUR / person
- Entry into 2 competitions: 90 EUR / person
- Entry into 3 competitions: 100 EUR / person

The participation fee includes the following services between August 30 and September 2, 2025:

- Entry permission to the designated parking area with 1 vehicle (maximum for a seven-passenger vehicle)
- Operating costs
- Entry right to accredited areas for one person (until 11:00 on September 3, 2025)
- Competitor rest zone
- Ship weighing and inspection
- Start number
- Eligibility to start in the events submitted during registration
- Providing bottled mineral water
- Exhibitor area
- Internet service
- Medals awarded to podium finishers
- Health insurance in the competition area
- The official event t-shirt (if you have paid your entry fee by August 10, 2025)
- Organizational costs
- Outdoor boat storage use
- Information and results reporting services
- Security service in the competition area
- Timing and results processing system

Fees for additional services not included in the participation fee, but optionally available:

- Registration of an accompanying person 45 EUR/person (Only persons over 18 years of age can register as companions.)
 - Lunch available for competitors and accompanying person (for the days between August 30 and September 2, 2025): 15 EUR / person / meal
 - additional parking sticker for the competitor: 50 EUR / accreditation period / car
 - additional t-shirt for the competitor: 12 EUR / pc
 - transfer service: based on individual offer
 - accommodation service: based on a unique offer
6. The participation regulations of the Masters Marathon World Championships are formed by these participation and payment conditions, the bulletin, the ICF and Organizer regulations, the information published on the official website of the event, and the data processing information.
 7. The participants of the competition: Participation in the competition does not require the country of the registered competitor to have ICF (International Canoe Federation) membership or MKKSZ (Hungarian Canoe Federation) competition license. Anyone can participate in the competition, as long as their participation is not restricted by the rules of the competition announcement.
 8. Only people who will be 35 years old in 2025 can participate in the competition.
 9. The nationality of the competitor is determined based on the competitor's permanent residence. A competitor may only represent the colors of one nation during the entire competition, even if participating in multiple events.
 10. By accepting the declaration of participation conditions, each participant declares that they participate in the above event at their own risk and are responsible for their own health, physical condition, and suitability for participation. He undertakes to compete in compliance with all ICF sports rules applicable to the Masters Marathon World Championships, to comply with the regulations of the Hungarian Canoe Federation as the Organizer during his participation, to participate in the event with sportsmanlike conduct, and to protect his own and his fellow athletes' physical integrity, his boat and other equipment. You acknowledge that you must compensate for any damage caused by violating the above, and the Organizer is not responsible for any negative changes in your health or physical condition that may occur during your participation in the competition. We do not require a mandatory sports medical examination, but we recommend that everyone, in their own interest, request a fitness test from their doctor before applying. Lack of inspection can also lead to a serious accident. At the Masters Marathon World Championships, an unexpected extreme weather event poses a serious mental and physical strain. It is not recommended for people with circulatory problems, diabetes, or those prone to tendinitis.
 11. If a second-degree storm warning is issued during the competition, participants must follow the instructions of the boat units (rescue teams) providing the event.
 12. It is prohibited to participate in the competition under the influence of alcohol or any mind-altering substances.
 13. Only experienced, trained, disciplined and healthy athletes should apply for the competition. Participants are obliged to provide their fellow participants with the assistance they are expected to provide.
